

# Penny Parrock Angling Co. Ltd.

## Fishing Rules

- 1) No shareholder is allowed to fish on Company waters until their subscriptions are fully up to date. Payment of the subscription automatically acknowledges a member's acceptance of the Company rules. Subscriptions fall due on the day of the AGM, and are valid until the following AGM.
- 2) A member may invite guests to fish providing that the member is present, and that the number of rods in use at any one time is no greater than the number of shares held, and on which the annual subscription has been paid. There must be no associated financial transaction.
- 3) No Shareholder shall have the right to issue permits and shall not allow any other person to fish waters owned or leased by the Company except as described in (2) above.
- 4) Members and their guests are entitled to fish in waters owned or leased by the Penny Parrock Angling Company Limited at any time during the season.
- 5) When fishing, and at all other times when on Company property, members and their guests are entirely responsible for their own safety and engage in all activities at their own risk.
- 6) All legal forms of fishing are allowed.
- 7) Members must not camp on land owned or leased by the Company.
- 8) No Shareholder of the Company should do any cutting down or trimming of trees, rushes or other vegetation unless a member of an official working party under the supervision of a Director of the Company. While fishing, and within reason, vegetation may be cut to enable the recovery of tackle.
- 9) Members must take their litter home, and are encouraged to pick up any litter present and take that home.
- 10) When other rods are present on the beat, members and their guests must fish with due regard to the other rods and the methods they are fishing; and abide by the following code of conduct :
  - a) If a pool is already occupied by a rod, another rod shall not also fish that pool unless invited.
  - b) If another rod is fishing in a mobile fashion, a second rod shall not start fishing in proximity to them, or in the water they are moving towards.
  - c) If bait fishing, do not occupy one position for more than one hour.
- 11) Members must carry their annual permit at all times while fishing, and must, on demand of any other member, produce it for inspection. Members must ask to see the permit of anyone who is fishing who they do not recognise. Permits are non-transferable.
- 12) At all times when fishing, and accessing our water, members and their guests must act with due consideration towards landowners and members of the public, and must not do anything that causes undue offence, or inconvenience.
- 13) All members must submit a return to the Company Secretary by the end of November each year, even if no fish were caught.
- 14) No member may sell any fish caught on Company waters.
- 15) Per share held :
  - a) No more than 2 salmon to be retained in any one day.
  - b) No more than 6 salmon to be retained per season.
  - c) No more than 4 Sea Trout may be retained per 24 hr period.Members are requested to return all unclean/coloured fish.
- 16) It is a condition of membership that members accept the rules and any member abusing the rules may be suspended from fishing at the discretion of the Directors.
- 17) Members must report to the Secretary all cases of poaching, illegal methods of fishing or breach of these rules.
- 18) Upon an offence being reported to the Secretary he will investigate, and if necessary call a meeting of the Board of Directors to consider the matter.
- 19) Any member disciplined by the Directors, shall have the right to appear before the Board of Directors to defend himself/herself or appeal against their decision. The decision of the Board shall be binding.
